10th Annual 3 on 3 Youth Basketball Tournament

The Blue Valley Booster Club and Business Professionals of America are sponsoring a youth 3 on 3 basketball tournament on Saturday, March 13 at Blue Valley High School. Games will start at 8:00 a.m. Boys and girls in grades 3-8 can participate. There is a maximum of four players to a team and teams are guaranteed 4 games each. Each team's entry fee is \$50. Teams are not coed, and the team must play in the division of the oldest player on the team. Some grade levels may need to be combined to make enough teams for a division. The contact person of each team will be notified of the time of play before the tournament and given the set of rules. A full breakfast and lunch will be available. A free throw contest will also be held throughout the day. Tournament t-shirts will be available to purchase. Medals will be awarded to the winning teams. A reminder: KSHSAA rules state that 7th and 8th graders can play with no more than 3 people from the same school.

Blue Valley Youth 3 on 3 Basketball Tournament Rules of Competition

Normal basketball rules will apply except for the following:

General Rules

1. Coin flip determines opening possession and home team. Officials will report this to the score keepers.
2. Possession changes on scores.
3. Ball must be checked by an opposing player before being put into play.
4. All non-shooting fouls and violations will be played out of bounds, top of court.
5. All out of bounds balls taken out top of court.
6. Take-back means both feet and ball behind the 3 point line.
7. Each team must have 3 players on the roster, and may have an additional player as a substitute. No more than 4 players on a team. Players must be 3rd through 8th graders. *7th and 8th grade- KSHSAA rules state no more than 3 players from the same school on a team.
8. All players must be on the roster by the tournament entry deadline. One player can be exchanged on the roster up until the first game played the day of the tournament. This is intended to allow for last minute illness of a player. A player may be on only one team roster.
9. Ball must be taken behind 3 point line on all change of possessions.
10. In the case of a jump ball, the possession goes to the defense.
11. In case of overtime, winners will be determined by a free throw shoot. The 3 players from each team on the court at the end of regulation time will alternate shooting free throws to determine a winner. Home team shoots first.
12. Pool play tiebreakers will be determined by: 1. head to head 2. total points scored (all games) 3. least points allowed (all games) 4. coin flip
13. On a jump ball, possession goes to the defense.

Scoring

1. Field goal worth one point.
2. Field goal from behind take-back line worth 2 points.
3. All games go to 15 points or 15 minutes.
4. Games will be 15 minutes with a 5-minute break between. Time clock runs continuously even through time-outs. If 15 points are not reached, the team ahead after 15 minutes is the winner. It is possible to score more than 15 points.

Time Outs

1. Each team is allowed one, 30-second time out per game (no time outs in the last minute of a game.) Time clock does not stop.
2. A team must have possession of the ball to call a time out.
3. If play is stopped by injury, injured player must sit out until next dead ball.
4. Player may substitute at any dead ball.

Fouls and Violations

1. Note the following change: **On shooting fouls, 1 free throw will be awarded to the player fouled for a regular shot and 2 free throws will be awarded if the player is shooting a 2-point basket. 1 free throw will be awarded if the basket is counted. If time runs out while shooting a free throw, the free throw is allowed.**
2. Any player misconduct or flagrant foul may result in ejection from the game and possible dismissal from the tournament.
3. No more than 5 fouls per player per game.
4. 3 second lane violation will be called.

General Play

1. All teams are guaranteed at least 4 games.
2. Teams are not coed, and must play in the division of the oldest player.
3. Depending on the number of teams in each division, teams will be divided into pools and then the winners of the pools will play a single-elimination bracket to determine the winner.
4. Medals will be awarded to the winner of each grade division, boys and girls.
5. Warm-up and game balls will be furnished. No other basketballs will be allowed in the building.
